Dear stakeholders,

I am pleased to inform you that the Immigration and Refugee Board of Canada (IRB) has released its latest quality report for the Immigration Appeal Division (IAD). As one of the strategies under our [Quality Assurance Framework](#), the IRB's divisions regularly undergo independent quality reviews of a selection of their decisions.

I encourage you to read [Quality performance in the Immigration Appeal Division 2021 to 2022](#) and review the [Summary Report](#). A [Management Response and Action Plan](#) (MRAP) has been developed to address areas for improvement.

Report summary

- **97% of hearings reviewed (68 out of 70) met or exceeded the high-quality standard.**
- Assessors commented positively about members' support for self-represented appellants, use of plain language, time management, and ability to ensure virtual hearings ran smoothly.
- The study reviewed 70 randomly-selected appeals finalized between April 1, 2021, and March 31, 2022.
- The sample was adjusted to ensure proportional representation for region and language of proceeding.

J'ai le plaisir de vous informer que la Commission de l'immigration et du statut de réfugié du Canada (CISR) a publié son dernier rapport en matière de qualité pour la Section d'appel de l'immigration (SAI). Comme le prévoit l'une des stratégies de notre [cadre d'assurance de la qualité](#), les sections de la CISR font régulièrement l'objet d'examen indépendants relativement à la qualité d'un échantillon de leurs décisions.

Je vous invite à lire le [rendement en matière de qualité à la Section d'appel de l'immigration pour 2021-2022](#) et à examiner le [rapport sommaire](#). Une [réponse et un plan d'action de la direction](#) ont été élaborés pour déterminer les points à améliorer.

Rapport sommaire

- **97 p. 100 des audiences examinées (68 sur 70) respectaient ou dépassaient la norme de qualité élevée.**
- Les évaluateurs ont formulé les commentaires positifs concernant le soutien fourni par les commissaires aux appelants non représentés, l'utilisation d'un langage simple, la gestion du temps et la capacité de s'assurer que les audiences virtuelles se déroulent bien.
- Dans le cadre de l'étude, 70 appels réglés entre le 1^{er} avril 2021 et le 31 mars 2022, qui ont été sélectionnés au hasard, ont été examinés.
- L'échantillon a été ajusté de façon à garantir une représentation proportionnelle des bureaux régionaux et de la langue des procédures.

CALL TO ACTION FROM MIGRANT RIGHTS NETWORK: In less than two weeks, **on September 16 and 17, 2023, thousands of us will take to the streets** from coast to coast to coast to demand equality, justice and permanent resident status for all. We are marching because in this **crisis of inequality**, we need to link struggles for climate justice, affordability, housing and human rights and migrant justice. **No one must be left behind.**

We are marching because **migrants** — the very people who grow food, care for the sick, build our homes, and keep society functioning — **bear some of the heaviest burden of exclusion,**
