For those of you who could not join us last MAP meeting for the MAP Advisory Council's presentation of proposed changes resulting from the Strategic Planning process, the voting outcomes are as follows:

1. The **Organizational Chart was approved** with some discussion around how the Advisory Council emerged and what replacing the Working Groups with Committees/Forums/Task force would mean. It was explained that the community and agencies would lead the organization of the committees/forums/task force around emerging issues. The responsibility for organization is on the agencies rather than MAP.
2. Mission and Vision - **The Mission was approved, but the Vision was not.** People had questions about what "inspired community" means and how the voices of refugee claimants are included. A comment was made that the community "welcoming" refugee claimants creates an "us versus them" narrative.
3. The **motion to continue working on the values was approved.**
4. The **Strategic Goals were approved**, with the suggestion that under Capacity Building, we specify that the term "equipping" means "equipping with resources and tools"

The Government of Canada (ESDC) is currently conducting a survey on the experiences of temporary foreign workers (TFWs) living and working in Canada to better understand the impacts of the Migrant Worker Support Program. Some of the questions asked are about TFW's knowledge of rights in both immigration and labour/employment, challenges faced and actions undertaken in response of those challenges and their resulting effect, workplace inspections, Open Work Permits and their success rate, and desire to obtain permanent residency.

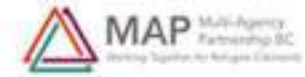
Join us for a **Multi-Sector World Café** on **Nov 28th** from **11:45am** at **Irving K. Barber, Dodson Room (302)**.

Sustaining Welcome webinar - Key implications for Canada's refugee policies now and in the future.

Join our webinar to discuss of the ground-breaking, multi-year report, [Sustaining Welcome](#).

The report brought together researchers and front-line workers to understand the early refugee settlement experiences of resettled Syrian refugees as they integrated into Canadian society.

Innovative in its approach, the authors contributed expertise from a range of disciplines, including psychology, social science, geography and epidemiology.

From 2017 to 2020, the authors interviewed 1,665 resettled Syrian former refugees across Canada each year, including 267 participants in BC who participated in all four years of the research. This longitudinal research allowed the authors to track changes among former Syrian refugees at the group and individual level over an extended period, revealing key group dynamics that would otherwise be missed in shorter studies.
