We are pleased to share that [My Refugee Claim](#) now has a dedicated registration page for [Appeal Ready Tours](#). These sessions support **refugee claimants, appellants, and service providers** to understand the process of making a refugee appeal in case of a negative decision. Whether claimants are still waiting for their hearing date, waiting for the outcome of their hearing, or have received a negative decision, this session is for all refugee claimants at any stage of the process who would like to learn more about how to make an appeal. Please note that it is recommended and requested that refugee claimants attend a [Hearing Ready Tour](#) first, so that they have the foundational knowledge about the refugee hearing before learning about the appeal process.



During an Appeal Ready Tour, participants will meet an officer of the Refugee Appeal Division of the Immigration and Refugee Board of Canada and have their questions answered:

- Who is eligible to appeal to the Refugee Appeal Division?
- What are the deadlines for filing an appeal?
- What do I need to do to file an appeal?

Appeal Ready Tours are available in English and French, and have the option for interpretation where needed. Sessions will run regularly and dates are listed on the website.
